 - -you can use fingers (pinching) instead of tweezers
 - you can use sand, rice or playdough in the bin

 - e.g. larger/easier items such as toy cars, small toys/figurines, small balls, beanbags
 - -e.g. small items such as marbles, bottle tops, beads, pom poms

b) Make a cake or pizza -

- For a cake:

- iii) Add birthday candles (can substitute with sticks/twigs)
- For a pizza:
- i) Flatten playdough into a pizza base

- iii) Sprinkle 'cheese e.g. sprinkles, sequence, glitter
